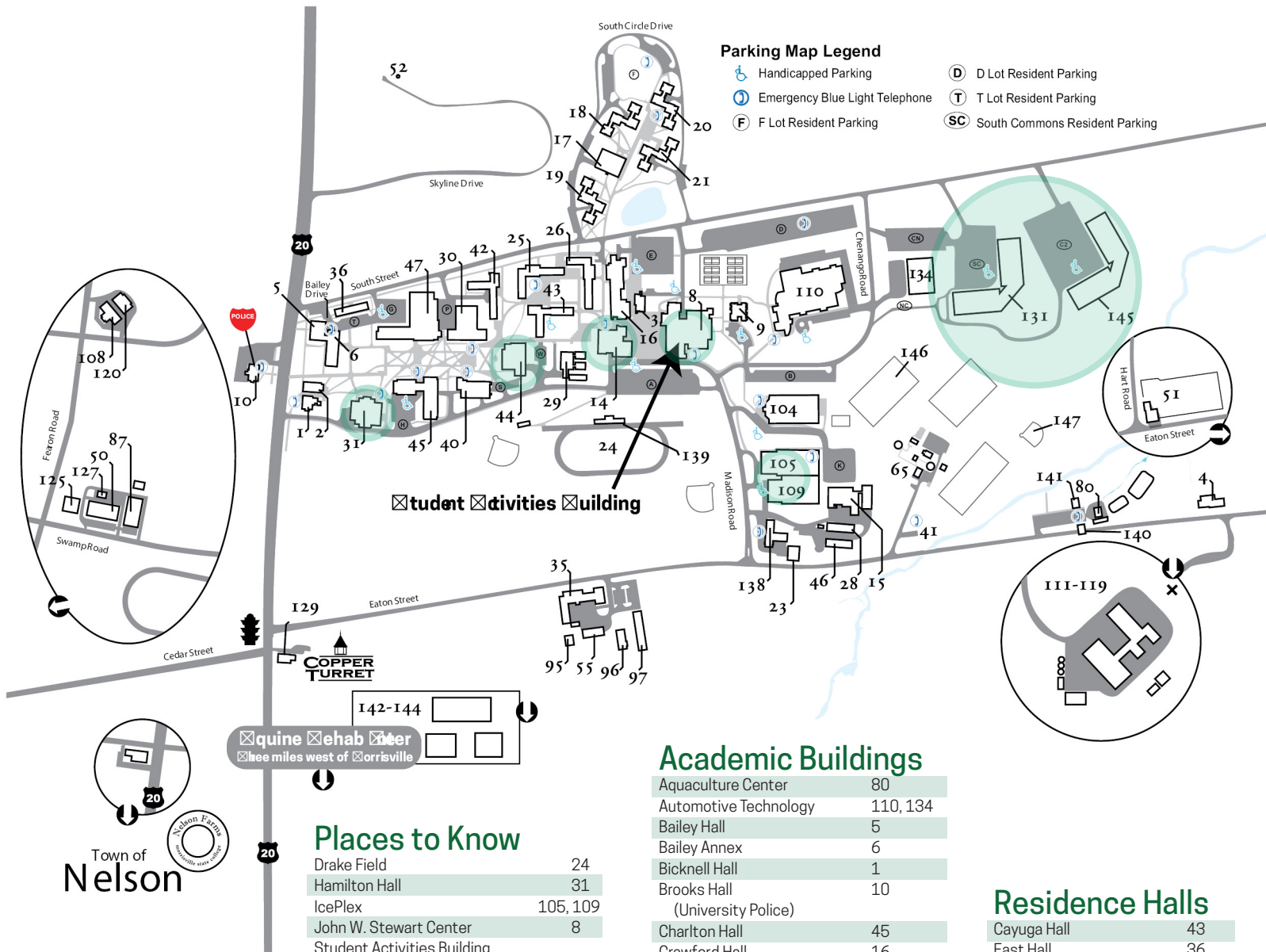

COLLEGE ID SERVICES AT THE TECH CENTER



Every student receives a SUNY Morrisville photo ID. Your ID is your passport to services on campus. You will use it to gain entrance into residence halls, computer labs and select classrooms, to pay for meals using your meal plan and Dining Points at our campus dining facilities, as identification for admission to campus functions, to check out materials at the campus library, and to use your Campus Cash and Dining Points at various locations both on and off campus.

The College ID Office is located in the Tech Center in Hamilton Hall. For more information visit: morrisville.edu/tech-center.

MEAL PLANS

All students living on campus are required to have a meal plan. All meal plans consist of a set number of **MEAL SWIPES** (also called **BOARDS**) available each week, a set amount of **DINING POINTS** for the semester that can be used for additional food purchases at all MAC dining locations, and a set number of Guest Meals. Purchases are non-taxable, and any balance remaining at the end of the semester is non-refundable. **Meal Plans are not available during academic breaks.**

MEAL SWIPES are simple; 1 Swipe = 1 Meal at Seneca Dining Hall, our all-you-care-to-eat location. *Note: Other locations may also accept Meal Swipes, which our cashiers will use first if available. Visit our website for more information.*

DINING POINTS is a declining balance of additional dollars to spend on food purchases. Points are mainly used at our a la carte locations (where you pay for what you order). Some locations accept both swipes and Dining Points.

DID YOU KNOW? Where you eat most often will help determine which meal plan is right for you; you have 2 weeks after classes start to make a plan change if needed!

CAMPUS CASH

Unless specifically indicated, Campus Cash is **not** a part of your meal plan; it is an separate declining balance account funded entirely by you and loaded onto the College ID card. Campus Cash can be used at MAC locations including Campus Stores, select vending machines, dining locations, as well as other participating merchants. Purchases are taxable and remaining balances are refundable at the end of the academic year if requested. DINING SERVICES

- MAC believes in providing great food at a great value to our campus community. While each of our facilities differs in concept, the dining service staff share a commitment to providing an exceptional dining experience. Chefs receive on-going off-site training and are committed to working with local farmers to source field to fork products.

- **SENECA DINING HALL** is our traditional all-you-care-to-eat dining hall located at the center of campus. Seneca features a variety of balanced and delicious meals throughout the day. Choose from freshly made deli sandwiches, hot entrées, soups, vegetables, grill items and an extensive salad bar. As an extra treat, Seneca also offers a delectable dessert bar. - **THE PIT STOP** is conveniently located next to Seneca, and serves as an on-the-go food convenience store. Here you'll find a wide range of beverages, snack items and individually packaged breakfast, lunch and dinner items. - **MUSTANG ALLEY** is our food court-style dining facility, located in the Student Activities Building (STUAC). Choose from salads, paninis, wraps, sandwiches, soups, made-to-order grill selections like burgers, Philly steaks, quesadillas, buffalo chicken sandwiches and fries, a variety of pastas and sauces, homemade hand-tossed pizzas, calzones, and daily entrée specials that highlight flavors of the world! - **SMOOTH JAZZY JOZ (SJJ)** is our specialty coffee and baked goods shop, located in the lobby of the Student Activities Building (STUAC). MARKET24 & VENDING

We have two conveniently located Market24 vending units on campus; one near Seneca Dining Hall, and the other in the Pond Quad by South Hall. Just like a 24-hour convenience store, these units carry a wide variety of products from food, beverages, snacks, health & beauty aids, cleaning supplies, as well as large packaged goods. In addition to the two Market24 locations, there are many traditional snack and beverage vending machines across campus. They can be found in all residence halls and most academic buildings. Market24 machines only accept Dining Points, and cash, while our vending machines accept cash, credit, or Campus Cash!



CABLE TV

Every room in every residence hall has **CABLE TV ACCESS**. Residents need to have a cable-ready TV (compatible with our Clear QAM 256 cable system) or converter box in order to use this service.

LAUNDRY

WASHERS & DRYERS are available for use in every residence hall at no additional charge.

MORRISVILLE COMMONS *APARTMENT-STYLE LIVING*

Morrisville Commons I & II offers students apartment-style living, just a quick walk or shuttle ride to all academic buildings. Both buildings provide a secure living environment with a live-in manager, and each fully furnished apartment offers full kitchens with a stove/oven, refrigerator & microwave, living rooms, single bedrooms and a bathroom. Wired Internet connections are located in each bedroom, and wireless internet service is available throughout each building. Community lounge areas provide opportunities to have fun while making friends with neighbors. Parking is available for all Commons residents at the standard campus fee.



TRANSPORTATION MAX, MORRISVILLE AREA XPRESS

MAX, Morrisville Area Xpress, is a campus shuttle service specifically designed to support the commuting needs of the SUNY Morrisville community. This convenient shuttle provides transportation to primary academic facilities on campus, outer-lying college facilities, scheduled shopping trips to area malls, shopping centers, and various recreation & entertainment outlets, "Rides for Residents" (transportation to urgent, but non-emergency appointments with health care providers), and evening transportation five nights a week. Service runs throughout the academic year, except during college breaks and holidays. All trips are funded by SUNY Morrisville's Transportation fee. MORRISVILLE ICEPLEX

The SUNY Morrisville IcePlex houses two regulation-sized rinks and serves as home ice for the SUNY Morrisville Mustang Varsity Hockey Teams, Center State Youth Hockey, and a variety of other hockey and skating programs open to both the campus and the community.

Nelson Farms is SUNY Morrisville's small-scale, FDA inspected, food processing incubator that provides entrepreneurial agri-business opportunities for specialty food processors, farmers, growers, and producers. SUNY Morrisville students in several programs of study use Nelson Farms as an experimental laboratory, gaining real-world experience in agritourism, marketing, entrepreneurship, dietetics/nutrition, and value-added agriculture and development.
